

The purpose of this congregation is to promote the enduring and fundamental principles of Judaism; to ensure the continuity of the Jewish people; to enable its adherents to develop a relationship to God and knowledge of our Jewish heritage through communal worship, study, and assembly; and to apply the principles of Reform Judaism to the values and conduct of the individual, family, and the society in which we live.

### ARTICLE III. NATIONAL AFFILIATION.

This congregation shall affiliate itself with the Union for Reform Judaism (URJ.) It shall pay dues to the URJ and be entitled to all services as well as privileges prescribed in the URJ Constitution and Bylaws.

### ARTICLE IV. RITUAL AND RELIGIOUS PRACTICE.

Section 1. The congregation shall interpret Judaism in the tradition of Reform Judaism.

Section 2. The official ritual of worship shall be according to rituals recommended by the Central Conference of American Rabbis.

Section 3. The Congregation shall be advised in its religious practices by its rabbi, as
